New Technology

Infinite Campus, Raptor, Schoology, SchoolCafe

By now, it is probable that you have seen some of the new technology tools and resources that the Park Hill School District has implemented this year.

While we know that everyone is not technology-savvy or may not have computer and internet access at home, we hope that you take an opportunity to utilize these new technology tools whenever possible.

Infinite Campus is our student information system. The Parent Portal gives parents or guardians immediate access to important student info such as grades, schedules, and attendance. It also allows you to view your household contact information and student emergency contacts, and you can request updates to this information directly from the parent portal.

Raptor is our new visitor sign in/out system. Please remember that you (or whomever is picking up your student) must have a driver's license in order to complete the check in/out process.

Schoology is the classroom student learning module. Teachers will be using this tool for a variety of purposes within their classroom instructions.

SchoolCafe is the new food service online payment program. This system replaces Meal Pay or MyPaymentsPlus. Parents must sign up for an account with the simple online registration.
